

# Pre-Lesson Comprehension

Target Language: *will (questions)*

**Focus:** In this lesson, you will learn how to *ask questions about the future with will*.

Read and understand the target language below.

We use **will** to talk about the future when there isn't a plan, when you have just made a decision, or when you guess about the future. For example:

- no plan:** Maybe I **will see** a movie this weekend.  
**just made a decision:** I don't feel well. I think I **will stay** home today.  
**guess about the future:** Rich **won't like** the dessert. It's too sweet!

When we ask questions with **will**, we use the following structures:

**Closed Questions: will + subject + base verb**

**Q:** **Will** you **buy** a new car?

**A:** Yes, I will. I have enough money.  
No, I won't. I don't have any money.

**Q:** **Will** you **see** a movie this weekend?

**A:** Yes, I will. There's a new romantic comedy at the theater.  
No, I won't. There aren't any good movies.

**Open Questions: wh-question + will + subject + base verb**

**Q:** **What will** you **do** tonight?

**A:** I will try to get home early and relax.

**Q:** **Where will** you **go** this weekend?

**A:** I don't know. I will drive into the city.
